## CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The National Coalition of Oncology Nurse Navigators is accepting abstracts for poster presentations at the 3<sup>rd</sup> NCONN Changing the Face of Cancer Care Conference. Presentations will be conducted at the welcome reception on the evening of September 8, 2011 at the Hilton San Diego Bayfront Hotel. This year's conference will focus on navigating the adult cancer patient, survivor, and the young adult cancer survivor.

Oncology Nurse Navigators, clinicians, program staff and researchers who work with adult and young adult cancer patients and survivors are encouraged to submit abstracts for poster presentation. We also encourage submission of abstracts that discuss any of the following areas related to navigation:

- Psychosocial well-being
- Outcome measurements in navigation
- Building a network of support for patients
- Navigation health system paradigms
- Documentation solutions
- Referral and marketing strategies
- Survivorship program implementation

## ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

Abstracts must be identified as one of the following:

Programmatic: Depicts innovative programs or practices that are being used to improve health care function and well being of the adult, young adult or cancer survivor as well as helping them to reach optimal survivorship.

Research: Studies that investigate recent efforts to reduce health inequalities in adult, young adult, and cancer survivors with background, rational for the need, methodology, results, conclusions, and research, clinical or programmatic implications.



Word limit:

Please limit the text of your abstract to 500 words (not including title, headers, or authors).

Text specifications

- Abstracts should be single-spaced and written in 12pt Times New Roman font
- Please bold face the name of the presenting author. The person designated as the presenting author is expected to register and pay the regular conference fee to attend the conference. The presenting author of an abstract can be changed at anytime.

Submit abstracts to conference@nconn.org by midnight July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2011. Please put "3<sup>rd</sup> NCONN Conference abstract" in the subject line.

Posters:

- If the abstract is accepted, the presenting author is expected to be available to present their poster at the welcome reception on September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2011 from 6:00-8:30PM
- Poster dimensions should be 3x5 feet
